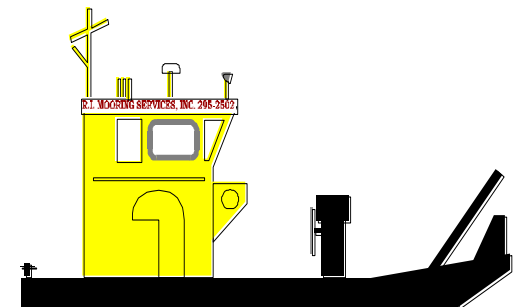

WHY SERVICE ?

Many mooring anchors can become embedded in the mud and can not be adequately surveyed by a diver. Also, due to currents and wind conditions, some mooring tackle can become worn in just a few years time. This poses a hazard to any boats on or near the mooring. If any piece of tackle breaks due to wear, the boat will drift free. This could cause severe damage to your vessel or others.

Rhode Island Mooring Services, Inc. (RIMS) has built a state-of-the-art work boat specifically to install and service moorings. The boat is designed so that we can safely haul the entire mooring on the deck for cleaning, inspections, and necessary repairs.

We service the anchor, mooring chain, shackles, swivel, buoy and pennant to meet the town or Harbor safety specifications and will replace any components that will jeopardize the safety of your vessel.

Boat owners are responsible to check their boat and lines regularly. Wind, tide, current, etc. can effect how a boat rides on a mooring. You should always check before & after extended absences as well as before or after high winds to monitor your line/pennant condition.

Mooring Annual Service

\$ 166.00 *per year

Fall Service

- Supply initial winter tackle set up.
- Remove and clean buoy and pennant
- Install winter stake or winter buoy
- Transport and store buoy and pennant.

Customer must remove pickup whip (mast buoy) at the end of the summer season. If we remove and store it there will be a \$17.00

Spring Service

- Paint bottom of buoy with antifouling paint. Repaint buoy name and number as necessary.
- Check all upper tackle, tighten and seize shackles.
- Replaced winter stake or winter buoy with mooring buoy and pennant.
- Replace any worn components necessary for mooring to meet the town safety requirements.

*** This is a group rate for moorings done in a field/area all at the same time (plus any materials if required).**

*Annual Service to mooring outside of a defined mooring field will be subject to an extra distance charges.

*For deep water moorings there is an additional charge based on depth. **Deep water moorings are moorings in over 30ft water.**

Annual Service fee covers Spring/Fall services described above. Any additional work orders during the season will be billed at our hourly rate plus materials.

Inspection Service

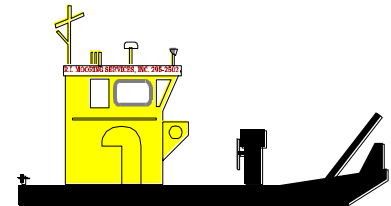
- Inspections are automatically scheduled every three (3) years.
- Complete haul out of entire mooring system, full on deck inspection.
- Check of all components from anchor to buoy.
- Worn components replaced as necessary for mooring to meet town or harbor safety requirements.

Inspection reports will be mailed after payment has been received.
